### About Obzor



**Obzor** (Bulgarian: Обзор; Thracian: *Naulochos*, Ancient Greek: Ναύλοχος, translit. *Naulochos*, Latin: *Naulochus*, *Tetranaulochus*, or *Templum Iovis*) is a small town and seaside resort on the Black Sea coast of Bulgaria. It is part of Nesebar municipality, Burgas Province.

The Thracian and ancient Greek name of Obzor was Naulochos, a small port on the coast of Thrace, a colony of Mesembria. The ancient Romans named it *Templum Iovis* (Temple of Jupiter); Pliny called it **Tetranaulochus**. During the Ottoman rule of Bulgaria, it was known as *Gözeke*. The modern name was introduced in 1936; Obzor obtained town privileges on 9 September 1984.

It has the largest beach in Bulgaria – 14 km

### **IN THE TERRITORY OF THE COMPLEX:**

Hotel, 3 star category, consisting of 4 buildings. The total number of rooms is 136, of which 6 are studios.

### **SERVICES:**

Outdoor pool / 12,5m x 25m. 2 meters, 5 corridors / with loungers, a large sports complex with football pitch, volleyball and basketball courts, table tennis, sports hall, stage where various events can be held, café, shop, 2 canteens with 400 seats, discotheque, hall equipped for basketball and volleyball, which can easily be retrofitted in both conference and dance classes.

**BEACH:** beach equipped with umbrellas. There is a constant savior on the beach (except at night).

Please note that **no visa is needed** for citizens of EU countries
- **Speed limit:**
  - Speed limit for **cars**:  
50 km/h within towns; 90 km/h outside towns; 140 km/h on motorways
  - Speed limit for **motorcycles, buses and trucks without trailers**:  
50 km/h within towns, 80 km/h outside towns, 100 km/h on motorways
  - Speed limit for **cars, buses and trucks with trailers**:  
50 km/h within towns, 70 km/h outside towns, 100 km/h on motorways
- **Vignettes**  
Vignettes are obligatory for all vehicles and are on expense of the arriving delegations.
- **Lights and seatbelts**
  - In Bulgaria is obligatory to have the lights on during daytime.
  - All seatbelts must be used where available.
- **Alcohol and tobacco**
  - Maximum alcohol that category A and B drivers may have in blood is 0.5 grams per kilogram. Smoking is strictly forbidden in all public places including Sports halls, restaurants, bars etc.
